



CONSENT TO PROSTHETIC EVALUATION AND TREATMENT

The average time required to build a prosthesis is one to two weeks. Each week should consist of two to three appointments lasting one to two hours. On occasion the process can be longer if a patient is a difficult fit or if the treatment plan changes.

On average there is no pain associated in the process of fabricating a prosthesis. On occasion a patient can experience pain associated with being fit with a hard diagnostic socket or applying pressures to sensitive areas.

Every attempt will be made in our office to successfully fit you with a prosthesis. The process is a team approach between the prosthetist and you. The prosthetist will not fabricate a prosthesis at your request that will increase your risk of harm.

A successful fit in our clinic is not a guarantee. We will make all attempts to provide you with the best possible care within our warranty period.

On occasion, although rare, a patient can experience increased pain due to wearing a prosthesis. Examples of this can include development of bone spurs, development of neuromas, increased phantom pain, and increased residual limb pain. Other medical care may be necessary in these instances.

If you deny treatment, future prosthetic treatment can be more difficult due to decreases in muscle strength and decreases in range of motion.
